They say, Who shall see them?

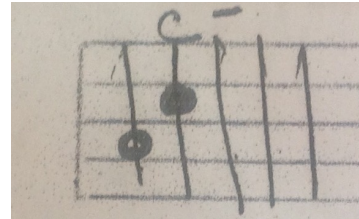
