

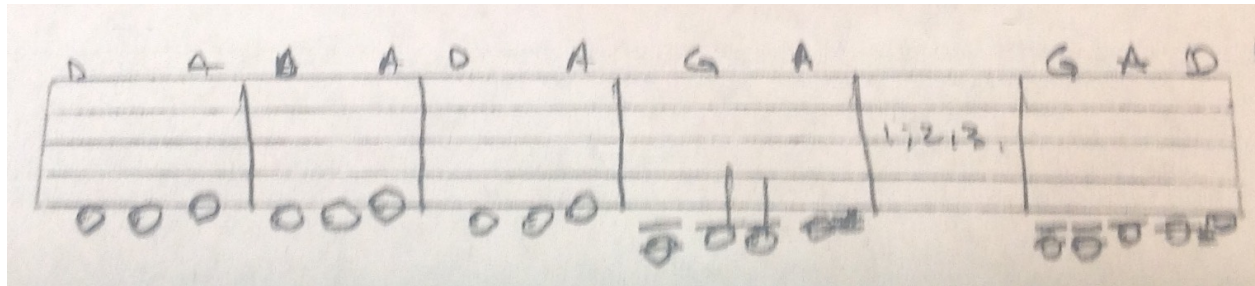

Makes us feel, like we must be fools

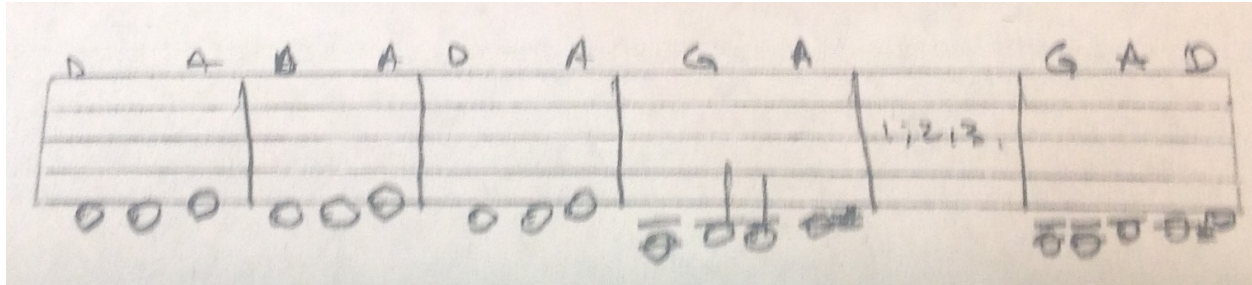
