

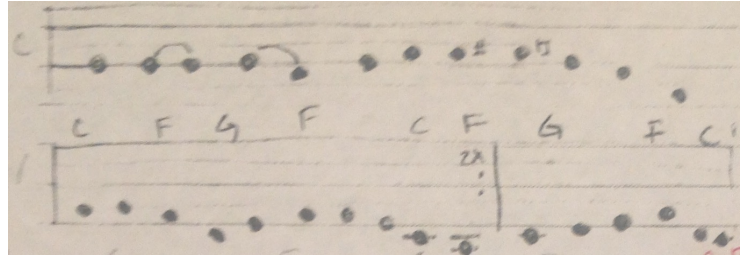

 Resolving to cooperate starting this day

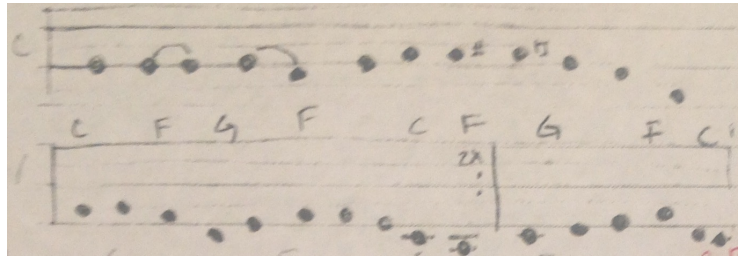
